A fee of \$25.00 will be levied for a returned check. All entries must be submitted on Official UKC entry forms, one dog per entry form. Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are not acceptable and will not be entered in the trial. Faxed entries and/or credit card payments cannot be accepted. Entries sent by overnight mail must not require a signature. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by judge or veterinarian, barred from competition by action of the show committee or UKC. No fees will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency or any other cause beyond the control of the show committee. Refunds will be given for bitches that come in season after the closing date of the trial minus a \$5.00 handling fee with a veterinarian's certificate prior to the start of the trial.

This is a tentative running order. It is subject to change or adjustment based on the actual number of entries received at each level. A final running order will be sent via email with a final confirmation and trial instructions.

Trial Information

If you do not pass the required PT test in the morning the club will refund you the element trial entry fees that were pre-paid. Refunds will be sent via mail within 10 days of the trial.

Move-ups will be allowed. Move-ups for Saturday's and Sunday's Trial 1 must be received by the Trial Secretary by Monday, Sept.9, 2019. Move-ups between Trial 1 and Trial 2 for each element will be allowed each day. Instructions for the move-up procedure between trials will be given at the judge's briefing.

Crating space will not be available indoors and handlers will need to plan to work from vehicles.

Food

No food will be available at the show site. Off-site luncheon options are available within a 10-20 minute drive from the trial site.

Notice to Exhibitors

A UKC PT or NACSW ORT is required for entry in a UKC element title trial for the level/odor entered. Copy of PT or ORT should be sent with entry.

"A" Section Classes - This section is open to all exhibitors and dogs that have not earned a title in the element in which they are entering or equivalent title in another organization. The exhibitor must own the dog entered or be a member of the owner's household or immediate family. Once the dog has earned the title they may no longer compete in the "A" section. No licensed or professional dog trainer or Nosework instructor, regardless of the person's status as an amateur or professional, may compete in this section. No person licensed to officiate Nosework in UKC or any other organization may compete in this section.

Exhibitors with more than one dog entered in a trial. Exhibitors may handle only one dog in each class, or element in each trial. An exhibitor may enter more than one dog in the same class or element so long as a separate handler is provided for each dog. Exhibitors may enter and handle more than one dog per trial provided the additional dog(s) are entered in a different class or element from all other entries being handled by that exhibitor.

A UKC registration number is required to participate in these trials. For information on UKC registration go to www.ukcdogs.com.

Awards and Prizes:

Placement ribbons will be provided for 1-4 placements in each class. Blue qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Ribbons will be provided for High in Trial for each trial at each level. A High Junior ribbon will be awarded for each trial for each level. New title ribbons will be offered for anyone earning a new element title. Rosettes also will be offered for those individuals completing their full level titles.

- 1. Nosework trials will include a pre-trial for the levels being run. Dogs need to pass the pre-trial for the level they are competing in. Dogs may be entered prior to passing, but must pass the pre-trial prior to competing that day. If the dog has passed on ORT in the applicable odor please submit a copy of proof.
- 2. Individual element classes are divided into Levels "N"-"E" and further divided into "A" and "B" sections depending on the experience of the dog and/or handler. Be sure to check the rules regarding the divisions. For these classes, dogs will only be searching the elements chosen.
- 3. Full Nosework Trials are divided into Levels "N"-"E" and further divided into "A" and "B" sections depending on the experience of the dog and/or handler. These trials contain all four elements. Each element passed earns a leg toward a title in that element.
- 4. Handler Discrimination. One glove will be used and must be provided by the handler.
- 5. All entries must be submitted on the current "Official UKC® Nosework Trial Entry Form".
- 6. Use a separate entry form for each dog entered in a club's event.
- 7. Nosework events are open to all UKC registered breeds and mixed-breed dogs with a valid Performance Listing/Limited Privilege number/Permanent Registration/Temporary Listing.
- 8. We want you to keep the points earned at UKC Licensed events. Important things to remember:
 - All dogs entering UKC events must be permanently registered, have a valid Temporary Listing Number, or a Performance Listing/Limited Privilege number.
 - Dog not UKC registered? Apply for a Temporary Listing Number (TL) online at www.ukcdogs.com/tl-numbers. (TL fees are non-refundable, non-transferable and do not apply to the cost of permanent registration.)
 - All entry forms must be completed and signed. Incorrect information submitted on the entry form may invalidate your wins.
- 9. The United Kennel Club complies with the Americans with Disabilities Act. If you require an accommodation, please contact the Event Chair or Secretary for this club's event.
